**MAE 870 Hierarchical Linear Modeling in Educational Research (3)** Hierarchical data structures, fixed effects, random effects, hierarchical linear models, null model, partition of variance, intraclass correlation, random intercept models, random coefficient models, growth models, repeated measures, educational research, and use of statistical software. It is strongly recommended that students have completed a course in applied statistics.
