Prerequisites — The following requirements must be completed prior to clear admission to graduate study: 25 undergraduate hours of chemistry from a combination of introductory chemistry, organic chemistry, analytical chemistry, biochemistry, inorganic, or physical chemistry (each with a laboratory component). ~~Additional requirements would be at least one semester of calculus, one year of physics, and completion of the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) general test with expected scores of 144 or higher on the Verbal and 150 or higher on the Quantitative portions of the exam (target score – 294).~~ Enrollment in graduate courses will be restricted until these prerequisites have been completed. For any student applying to the program with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 (domestic) or 3.0 (international) or EKU students applying to the M.S. program through the 3+2 accelerated Dual Degree Program, the GRE general test will be waived.
