Eastern Kentucky University, located at the nexus of the Bluegrass Region and the Appalachian foothills in Richmond, Kentucky, is a student-centered comprehensive regional university dedicated to high-quality instruction, service and scholarship. The Richmond campus has long been known as "The Campus Beautiful" for its attractive landscapes. About a decade ago, the university underwent the most ambitious campus revitalization in the institution's history, adding a number of new facilities, including: a student fitness and wellness center, a state-of-the-art science building, two residence halls, a Scholar House for single parents and a dining hall. In recent years, EKU has elevated commitments to students with innovative programs like EKU BookSmart and the Exceptional Eastern Experience (E3). EKU BookSmart provides free textbooks to all degree-seeking students. E3 offers students a well-rounded college experience through engaging events and concerts.
